**St. Joseph, Mo.** — Oct. 2, 2003— Missouri Western State College announces recent achievements by their faculty and staff:

- Dr. Robert Nulph, associate professor of video art, earned three awards for his work “The St. Joseph Symphony Petting Zoo:” a first place Open Division/Education Category at the KAN Film Festival held on the campus of the University of Kansas, Lawrence, in June; an Omni Intermedia Award, an international award that recognizes outstanding television, video and film productions; and a Bronze “Telly Award,” considered one of the most prestigious awards that recognize outstanding nonbroadcast video and film productions.
