WESTERN HOSTS HISTORY BOWL

St. Joseph, Mo. — Sept. 28, 2004 — Missouri Western State College will host the 14th annual History Bowl for area high schools in northwest Missouri from 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. Oct. 16 in the Frank Popplewell Administration Building, rooms 104 and 105.

Local area schools will participate in the one-day double elimination tournament event, which will feature questions relating to all historical areas in all regions of the world.

“The history bowl fosters academic competition among regional high schools,” said Dr. Steven Greiert, professor of history at Western. “This requires students to read and study as much as possible about people, events, and ideas that have greatly affected the past as well as our present world.”
