WESTERN TO OFFER DRIVERS EDUCATION

St. Joseph, Mo. —April 2, 2003—In collaboration with the St. Joseph School District, Missouri Western State College is offering drivers education to high school students ages 15 to 19. Two sessions will be held: June 9 through June 20 and July 7 through July 18. Each session will include driving time. The class will meet from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Course enrollment will begin at 8 a.m. on April 11 in the Leah Spratt Multipurpose Classroom building, room 105. The cost to students is \$25. All students must be currently enrolled in, and not graduated from, high school. People who do not meet the requirements can enroll at a cost of \$225. Registration forms are available on the Western website and at the continuing education office. A copy of the student's birth certificate and social security number must accompany the registration.
