WESTERN ANNOUNCES FACULTY AND STAFF ACHIEVEMENTS

St. Joseph, Mo. — April 30, 2004—Missouri Western State College announces recent achievements of their faculty and staff:

- Jill Miller, professor of criminal justice and department chair, placed third in the professional division at the national conference of the American Criminal Justice Association in the professional division. She, along with student Shelly Fritz and a professional member from California, placed first in crime scene investigation competition at the professional level.
- Dr. Todd Eckdahl, professor of biology, and three faculty from Pomona College and Davidson College were awarded a \$39,640 grant by the National Science Foundation (NSF) to conduct a summer 2004 workshop at Georgetown University in Washington DC to prepare professors from across the country to use micro arrays in their undergraduate teaching and research. The team was previously successful with a \$15,000 workshop proposal and a \$105,390 equipment proposal to NSF.
- Jeff Wilson, coordinator of student employment, received the Award for Excellence in Higher Education from Northland Regional Chamber of Commerce. The Chamber recognizes educators and people in service to education for their outstanding and noteworthy contributions.
