EARLY REGISTRATION DEADLINE JULY 18

St. Joseph, Mo. —July 14, 2003—To attend the last early registration and orientation scheduled this summer at Missouri Western State College, first-year and transfer students must have all of their application materials to the admissions office by July 18.

Early registration and orientation sessions are offered periodically throughout the summer to introduce first-time and transfer students to Western. Students have the opportunity to learn about the college, meet with an advisor, and complete the registration process.

To be invited to the August early registration session, first-year students must submit an application, fee, official high school transcripts, ACT scores and Missouri Core Curriculum form. Transfer students must submit the application, fee and official transcripts from all colleges they have attended. The admissions office must receive all materials by July 18.
