Applicants who are not citizens of the United States must receive a score of 550 or above on the paper-based or 61 or above on the internet-based Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL), unless the applicant is from a country where English is the native language or they possess a baccalaureate degree from a college or university in which the primary language of instruction was English.
