

Installing the Novell GroupWise Client for Linux

(Client version 8.0.2 hp2)

The following instructions are designed for SUSE Enterprise Desktop Linux 10/11. Other Linux variants, such as Ubuntu, may be slightly different and have not been tested.

System Requirements:

- x86-32 processor or x86-64 processor (on a 64-bit processor, GroupWise still runs as a 32-bit application)
- Java Virtual Machine (JVM) 1.5 or later
- 200 MB of free disk space to install the GroupWise Linux client

Installation:

1. At your Linux workstation, download the GroupWise client compressed tar file to a temporary directory:

```
gw802_hp2_client_linux_multi.tar.gz
```

2. In a terminal window at your Linux workstation, change to the temporary directory, then use the following command to decompress and untar the downloaded file:

```
tar -xvzf
```

The files are extracted to the root of the directory.

3. In a terminal window, become root by entering `su -` and the root password.

4. In the directory where you extracted the GroupWise 8 Support Pack 2 HP2 client files, run the GroupWise Setup program to install the GroupWise Linux client software:

```
./install
```

5. To start the Linux client after installation, double-click the GroupWise icon on your Linux desktop.
