

2007 Voluntary Support of Education Survey Missouri Western State University

Council for the Aid to Education 's Voluntary Support of Education (VSE) survey is the authoritative national source of information on private giving to higher education and private K-12 schools, consistently capturing about 85 percent of the total voluntary support to colleges and universities in the United States. CAE has managed the survey - now conducted entirely online - as a public service for over 40 years.

About a quarter of the nation's 4,000 institutions of higher education and about 250 pre-collegiate institutions fill out a survey each year. The survey collects data about charitable support, such as the source of gifts, the purposes for which they are earmarked, and the size of the largest gifts. Data on deferred giving and bequests are also collected. Questions about enrollment, expenditures, and endowment enable users of data to control for the size of the institution when conducting comparative research.
