



# in FRANCE

## Université d'Angers Angers, France

**The Program:** Missouri Western has entered into a direct exchange agreement with the Université d'Angers in Angers, France. Angers, a city with 250,000 inhabitants, is situated in the Loire Valley in the west of France. It is best known for its medieval castle, the Château d'Angers (1230), its magnificent cathedral, and its beautiful countryside. Angers is less than 2 hours from Paris.

**Academic Program & Calendar:** Students with twelve hours of French can enroll in intensive French language classes at the Université d'Angers. Students with eighteen hours of French can enroll in French language and civilization courses and in other disciplines. Fall Semester is October - Mid-February; Spring Semester is Mid-February - June.

**Room & Board:** Students stay in the University's dormitories (paying housing costs to Missouri Western). Students receive a stipend for meals at the Université d'Angers cafeteria or independently.

**Program Costs:** All scholarships can be applied to this direct exchange:

MWSU Tuition (12 credits)	\$2281 (in state)/\$3932 (out of state)
Housing and meals	\$3801
Administration Fee	\$ 250

Other costs: Airfare, books, and incidental costs are additional and will vary from student to student. Departmental scholarships are available to help defray costs.

**Eligibility:** Sophomores, juniors, and seniors, with a minimum overall GPA of 2.7 are eligible to apply for the exchange. Applicants must express a strong desire to learn French and must be in good academic standing at the time of departure. French majors will be given preference.

**CREDIT:** Up to 12-15 credit hours of academic work at UA may be transferred to Western and recorded on the Western transcript. Letter grades will be recorded on the student's Western transcript upon return. Students should confer with French faculty before going to France and should return to Missouri Western with appropriate materials for faculty to evaluate course content, such as syllabi, written work, exams.

**APPLICATION PROCEDURE:** Application materials are available from the Department of English, Foreign Languages & Journalism and must be completed by October 15th for the Spring Semester and by February 15th for the Fall Semester. Upon receipt of the application and supporting materials, each candidate will be interviewed by the selection committee.
