- Minimum of a 3.2 cumulative grade point average.
- Completion of a minimum of 90 undergraduate credit hours (senior standing).
- Must enroll and complete nine hours of graduate course work per semester.

Please attach the following to your application:

- Copy of college or university transcript.
- Statement of financial need (yearly income of parents if a dependent; personal yearly income if independent. This does include spouse income.)
- *Undergraduate students only*, please submit:
 1. A recommendation from your academic department chairperson.
 2. Recommendations from two MWSU faculty members.
 3. Letter of application describing your future career goals and how you feel this scholarship will aid you in the achievement of your goals. Please include a description of your extracurricular activities while in attendance at Western.
 4. List of scholarships and other financial aid you will be receiving.
- *Currently enrolled graduate students only*, please submit:
 1. A recommendation from one faculty member of the graduate school in which you are enrolled.
 2. A list of scholarships and other financial aid you will be receiving.

JOHN SUBLETT LOGAN BUSINESS FELLOWSHIP

Missouri Western currently has a fellowship program to assist eligible students in continuing their education at graduate school. The John Sublett Logan Business Fellowship is to assist outstanding students to obtain a graduate degree in Business, Law, Accounting or Economics.

Criteria

1. Superior performance in the individual's course of study.
2. A minimum of a 3.2 cumulative grade point average.
3. Completion of a minimum of 90 semester credit hours (senior standing).
4. Completion of a letter of application by the candidate describing his or her future career goals, and how he or she feels this scholarship will aid in the achievement of these goals. Additionally, this letter should include a description of the student's extracurricular activities while in attendance at Missouri Western State University.
5. A statement of financial need is required (yearly income of parents if a dependent, or personal income if independent). It is not necessary to supply actual copies of tax forms.
6. If you are an undergraduate student, please submit: a. Recommendation from your academic department chairperson. b. Two recommendations from Missouri Western faculty.
7. Confirmation of enrollment at a designated graduate school at time of award disbursement.
8. Candidate must enroll and complete nine hours the first semester to receive second semester grant.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
