

## **SENIOR DIVISION POSTER PRESENTATIONS**

Posters for the Senior Division should be setup on Saturday morning, April 21, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. and attended during the morning coffee break.

Posters will be grouped roughly according to discipline.

Posters should be no more than 4' x 4' and be freestanding and may be set on tables provided.

### **POSTER GUIDELINES**

The title of your poster should include the name(s) and institution(s) of the author(s). Because posters are a reflection of the presenter and his or her institution, it is important to create a good impression. Design your poster to look professional and to be easily read.

Along with an abstract and written text you can also present graphs, tables, drawings and pictures. Posters should be clear and concise.

Posters should be readable from a distance of 4 feet. The smallest readable type font at this distance is 20 point. If you have to resort to a smaller font size, you are using too much text. Artwork, photos, charts, and graphs typically make up the bulk of a good poster. Detailed information is more effectively conveyed in printed handouts that can be read.

Multimedia equipment (audiovisual or projection) will not be available and there are a **VERY LIMITED** number of electrical outlets in the poster display rooms.
