



Transfer Articulation Guide for Associate in Applied Science in Business Management to Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in Finance

Pursuant to the Articulation Partnership between Missouri Western State University (MWSU) and the North Central Missouri College (NCMC), this document serves as the Transfer Articulation Guide between MWSU and NCMC for the degree program of **BSBA-Finance**. This Transfer Articulation Guide is entered into pursuant to the Articulation Partnership between MWSU and NCMC and is effective beginning Fall 2025.

This transfer guide is provided as a service and is updated as needed. Degree requirements at the institutions are subject to change. To ensure you have the most accurate up to date information about the program, it is important you meet with an advisor at the transfer institution.

Program Entrance Requirements

- ACT composite score of 21 or higher or a high school GPA of 3.5 or higher, OR, 30 university credit hours and have an overall college GPA of 2.5 or higher and have a grade of C or higher in each of the following courses: i) ACC 201 or ACC 202, ii) GBA 201, iii) GBA 210, iv) GBA 211.
- Bachelor's degree program listed above officially declared on the MWSU student record (indicated at time admission or upon meeting with an advisor.)

Degree Requirements

- Earn a minimum of 120 hours (100 level and higher, maximum of 6 CED credit hours applicable).
- Earn a minimum of 30 credit hours in upper division courses. Lower division transfer courses accepted as meeting upper division departmental course requirements cannot be used to fulfill this requirement.
- Earn 30 of the last 45 credit hours at MWSU in institutional course work (exclusive of credit by exam).
- Participate in required departmental and campus wide assessments.
- Earn an overall GPA at least 2.0 and a major GPA of at least 2.0 GPA (with no more than 6 credit hours of D in major coursework).
- Fulfill the Missouri Constitution requirement.
- Successfully pass the Missouri Higher Education Civics Achievement exam.
