Day 1: Flight to Cairo - May 20, 2020 * - Wednesday

Depart USA to Cairo. Enjoy a hot Dinner aboard the airplane.

Day 2: Arrival in Egypt

Welcome to Egypt! Our representative will meet and greet you at the airport after you clear customs and then will escort you to your hotel in Giza. The rest of the day is free. Dinner and Overnight in Cairo (B, D)

Day 3: The Pyramids and the Sphinx

After breakfast you will meet your tour director, also a professional Egyptologist, and an expert in the history and anthropology of Egypt. Today, your tour takes you to fascinating sites of ancient Egypt. The pyramids of Giza are the only "Wonder of the Ancient World" to have survived the modern era. Your guided sightseeing tour introduces you to the three pyramids here, including the stunning Great Pyramid of Cheops. Then visit the enigmatic Sphinx. Continue to Saggara and Memphis, which was the ancient capital of Egypt. Dinner and Overnight in Cairo (B, D)

Day 4: Tour of Alexandria

After breakfast we will tour Alexandria (weather permitting), where you'll see the new Library of Alexandria, the Catacombs, Montassa and the Amphi Theater. Dinner and Overnight in Cairo (B, D)

Day 5: Cairo

After breakfast you will visit Old Cairo (Moallakah Church, Saint Sergius. In the afternoon enjoy some shopping time at the Bazaar. (B, D)

Day 6: Luxor and Cruise on River Nile - Monday - May 25, 2020

Fly to Luxor to begin the cruise portion of your Egyptian tour. Spend the day touring the Nile's West Bank. Your tour director/Egyptologist leads you to the Valley of the Kings, a series of tombs hidden in the Theban Hills. This "Place of Truth," as the ancient Egyptians called it, is the location of the tombs of Pharaohs Turankhamun and Ramses. You'll enter the tombs for a tour. Then visit and tour the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, devoted to one of the few female pharaohs. Also view the 64-foot-high Colossi of Memnon and tour the Valley of Nobles, whose temples depict amazing scenes of daily Egyptian life. Tonight, attend a sound and light show. Overnight aboard cruise ship (B, L, D)

Day 7: West Bank

This morning, explore the painstakingly excavated Temples of Karnak and Luxor, once connected by an avenue of sphinxes. Your tour director/Egyptologist takes you inside the temples for guided tours. Later, sail towards Edfu. Overnight aboard cruise ship (B, L, D)

Day 8: Edfu, Kom Ombo & Aswan

This morning, visit the Temple of Horus. Built nearly 2,000 years ago, this amazingly well-preserved temple is a perfect example of the architecture of its era. Next, sail to Kom Ombo. Visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, built during the Greco-Roman period. The temple is noted for its twin deities, Sobek and Horus. Arrive later today in Aswan. Overnight aboard cruise ship (B, L, D)

Day 9: Aswan Dam

Enjoy a visit to the Aswan Dam, one of the greatest engineering projects of the 20th century. Also view the Temple of Isis at Philae and the "unfinished Obelisk," once destined to be the largest structure of stone in the world. In the afternoon: You'll take a felucca (boat) ride past Elephantine Island, on which lies the frontier fortress of Egypt. The island takes its name from the dark granite rocks at its southern end, which resemble a herd of elephants bathing on the river. Also view the mausoleum of Agha Khan, which is situated on a hill with panoramic views. Overnight aboard cruise ship (B, L, D)

Day 10: Aswan

Your cruise ends with disembarkation this morning in Aswan.

Fly from Aswan to Abu-Simbel. Visit the temples of Abu-Simbel.


Return from Abu-Simbel to Cairo either directly or via Aswan (connecting flights) depending on availability. Tonight, attend an Egyptian Folklore Evening, dinner and overnight in Cairo. (B, D)

Day 11: Sightseeing of Cairo

Your tour director/Egyptologist will lead a sightseeing tour of Cairo. The city's mosques, of which there are more than 500, display some of the finest examples of Islamic architecture in the world. Visit the Citadel and Mohammed Ali Mosque, also known as the Alabaster Mosque. Built in the 12th century by mighty Salah el-Din. The Citadel was originally used as a fortress and was the residence of the Sultans until 1850. Also visit the Egyptian Antiquities Museum, which houses the famous masks of Tutankhamen. Later, roam through the winding streets and alleyways of the Khan-el Khalili Bazaar. Dinner and Overnight in Cairo. (B, D)

Day 12: Return Home - Sunday - May 31, 2020 *

Transfer to Cairo airport for your flight back to USA. Arrive home.



All sites listed in the itinerary will be covered but the sequence and days may be altered to adjust to religious holidays, special closings of sites, air schedules, etc. This tour is not recommended for those who have mobility limitations since it includes walking on uneven terrain

RESERVATIONS & PAYMENTS: A deposit check, as stated on this reservation form, per person and this signed Passenger Reservation Form Contract are required to secure a reservation. There are no telephone reservations. Reservations are taken on a first come - first served basis. Trip cost is based on minimum number of passengers, as specified in the trip itinerary. FULL payment for the tour, by check, money order or credit card, must be received at Jerusalem Tours International (JTI), so as to reach our office no later than 90 days prior to the tour departure date. Reservations may be canceled and JTI reserves the right to levy full cancellation charges as set forth in these terms & conditions, if full payment is not received 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour. Based upon availability, a reservation received less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour will be subject to a \$50 late fee and must be paid in full. Payments can be made by a check or credit card. No personal checks will be accepted with payments received 60 days or less before departure date, only money orders, cashier's check or credit cards will be accepted. No reservations will be accepted 25 days or less before departure. Travel insurance premium should be paid with the deposit check should you want to cover pre-existing conditions.

TOUR PRICES: The prices reflect a 4% discount for purchases made with cash or checks (should credit card companies raise their fees, this discount might change accordingly). There are no discounts for payments made on any credit cards. We accept Visa, MasterCard and American Express for payments. Credit card charges can also be submitted over the telephone upon customer's consent. By signing this reservation contract the customer grants permission to Jerusalem Tours International to charge his credit card for travel services described in this reservation contract and on the customer's invoice. Customer agrees to make payments to credit card Company in accordance with their policy upon receiving their bill.

PLEASE NOTE in case of human or computer error, Jerusalem Tours International (JTI) and CruiseXcel & Vacation Center (CXL) reserves the right to re-invoice for the correct price or service. CANCELLATION: All cancellations must be in writing to ITI or CXL and must be signed by the person who made the original reservation. Cancellations are only effective from the day they are actually received by ITI or CXL. Postmark prevails. No refunds are issued for cancellations received after the departure date of the tour and there is no refund for unused services. Penalties will apply. (See holdface print in the Responsibility and Liability section for company cancellations). If you cancel your tour, cancellation fees and penalties will be deducted from your refund.
