## Symbols of Academic Tradition and Excellence

Pageantry, honor, and celebration are traditional elements of university commencements and other academic ceremonies. As symbols of events and affiliations, academic regalia and medallions can be traced back to the Middle Ages. With Missouri Western's designation as a University, three symbols have become a part of the academic tradition at Missouri Western State University.

Seal: The seal is the official visual representation of the University as a legal entity and is to be used on official documents of the institution. The University seal is circular with the name Missouri Western State University and the year of the institution's founding, 1915, in the outer ring. The six core values that are fundamental to Missouri Western's mission are listed in the next ring of print. They are Service, Quality, Enthusiasm, Freedom, Respect, and Courage. The center of the seal features the Griffon, a mythical creature first conceived in Europe in the Middle Ages that combines the body of the lion and the eagle. It may be understood to symbolize courage and imagination. The Griffon is also known as the protector of "treasure." Recognizing that education is a treasure to be valued, the Griffon was selected to represent the higher education mission of the St. Joseph Junior College and has endured as Missouri Western's symbol since that time. It is the one symbol that unites the many generations of alumni through the various stages of the University's development. The Griffon as a symbol for Missouri Western has evolved over the years, and the current design is in the silhouette of the State of Missouri.

*Mace:* Symbolic since the Middle Ages of the community of scholars, the mace is carried in academic processions at many universities. The Missouri Western mace is made of local walnut and is adorned with brass and ebony rings. The head of the mace bears an etched image of the Griffon, and brass medallions of the University seal are on each of the mace's four sides.

*Presidential Medallion:* The presidential medallion represents the authority and responsibility of the Office of the President. It is conferred upon the President of the University by the Board of Governors and becomes a part of the academic regalia of the President of Missouri Western State University. The medallion features the seal of the University, a center link engraved with the title "President," and six links engraved with the University's six core values.

The original mace, processional banners and the presidential medallion were made possible by a generous gift from Dr. Joseph Friedman '39 in August 2005. A new mace was created by the St. Joseph Woodworkers Guild and dedicated in April 2019. The mace's medallions and etching were provided by David Takes of Expressions Engraved. Missouri Western acknowledges Dr. Friedman, the St. Joseph Woodworkers Guild and Mr. Takes with great appreciation.

## Symbols of Academic Tradition and Excellence Stoles and Cords

**African-American:** A red, green, and black Pan-African sash represents a worldwide movement to recognize the cultural connection between Africa's indigenous and diaspora ethnic groups.

**Asian American:** A red sash with a lotus flower that depicts the culture of the Asian and Pacific Islander cultures.

Commuter and Contemporary Students (Formerly known as the Non-Traditional Student): MWSU recognizes resilient commuters and contemporary student graduates by awarding a black stole highlighted with "Grit" on the right sash and the word "Determination" on the left sash.

**First Generation:** Students who do not have a parent who has completed a baccalaureate degree are honored with a 1.5" zipper pull medallion that can be attached to the graduation gown. This medallion represents a First-Generation college student's strength and perseverance. It's a proud reminder of their journey and serves as a motivational symbol for future endeavors.

**Greek Social Fraternities and Sororities**: These stoles are easily identified by the Greek letters that are displayed on them; however the design and color can vary even within one organization. This is due to stoles often being passed down from one generation to the next.

**Indigenous:** A multicolored sash tipped with fringes that celebrate the heritage and achievement of our Indigenous and native students.

**International Students:** Stoles represent each students' country of origin, so they vary in design and color.

**LatinX:** A sash of bold colors that represent different aspects of life and tradition and serves as a powerful symbol of identity, resilience, and success in the Hispanic and Latin American cultures.

**Legacy Cord:** The Missouri Western Alumni Association gives legacy students an antique gold legacy cord to recognize the connection they share with family members who have graduated before them. Undergraduate and graduate students with parents, step-parents and grandparents who are MWSU graduates are considered legacies.


**LGBTQ+:** A lavender stole with an eight-stripe Philadelphia rainbow on sash. The eight-stripe rainbow is enhanced with a black and brown stripe showing solidarity with African-American and Latino LGBTQ+ members.

**Military and Veterans:** MWSU recognizes student veterans, military students and ROTC students with Military and Veteran Honor Cords to wear at graduation. These red, white, and blue cords are a special recognition for those who have made an unwavering commitment to both our nation and their academic studies.

**Registered Student Organizations:** Stoles represent the graduates' participation in the organization. The stoles vary in design and color.

**Student Athletes:** Stoles are provided to graduating students who have been a member in good standing on one or more of the athletic teams sponsored by the Missouri Western Department of Athletics.

## Academic Attire

The colored lining of the interior of the hood is the official color or colors of the institution granting the degree.

The binding or edging of the hood is of velvet or velveteen and represents the faculty or department.

The colors of representative fields are:

White - Arts, Letters and Humanities; Drab - Commerce and Business Administration; Light Blue - Education; Orange - Engineering; Brown - Fine Arts; Purple - Law; Lemon - Library Science; Pink - Music; Apricot - Nursing; Dark Blue - Philosophy; Sage Green - Physical Education; Yellow - Science; Scarlet - Theology.

The gown for the bachelor's degree has pointed sleeves and is worn closed. The gown for the master's degree has an oblong sleeve, open at the wrist with the rear part of its oblong shape square cut and the front part with an arc cutaway. It may be worn open or closed.

The doctor's gown is faced with black velvet and has three bars across the bell-shaped sleeves. These facings and crossbars may be of colored velvet to represent the degree, and agree in color with the binding or edging of the hood. The tassel for the doctor's cap may be of gold thread.
