### DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

- Earn a minimum of 124 credit hours, including 45 from a senior college (100 level and above, maximum of 6 CED credit hours applicable).
- Earn a minimum of 30 credit hours in upper division courses, with a minimum of 15 credit hours being earned at MWSU. Lower division transfer courses accepted as meeting upper division departmental course requirements cannot be used to fulfill this requirement.
- Earn 30 of the last 45 credit hours at MWSU in institutional course work (exclusive of credit by examination).
- Participate in required departmental and campus wide assessments.
- Earn an overall GPA of at least 2.0 and a GPA of at least 2.0 in each concentration.

### ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Successful completion of 75 credit hours
- Overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- Completion of General Studies Math and English requirements with grades of C or better

### MAJOR REQUIREMENTS (36-48 Credits)

- First Concentration consists of a MWSU minor
- Second Concentration consists of a second MWSU minor or a custom concentration modeled after a major or minor degree program at a regionally accredited institution
- Second Concentration must contain a minimum of 18 hours of courses that do not duplicate courses in the First Concentration
- A Second Concentration using the custom format must contain a minimum of 9 hours 300 level or above
- An approved credit-bearing applied learning course must be present in one of the identified concentration areas
- No more than 2 D's allowed in both concentrations combined
