COURSE NAME: Undergraduate Research and Internship Practicum

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course offers under graduate students in the CS/CIS/ACT programs an opportunity to integrate theory with practice. Students work full-time or part-time for a company in a position related to their undergraduate program. Anticipated learning objectives are established in a contract agreed to by the student, the company supervisor, and the departmental faculty sponsor. May be repeated for credit, but at most 3 hours may count towards the total number of hours required for the degree program.

PREREQUISITE:

Minimum GPA of 3.0, and permission of the faculty sponsor.
Can enroll any time during their program.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS:

Students must keep a weekly journal of the activities of their work environment. These should be related to the learning objectives and the functions of the job that enhance their career objectives.

Students must submit a 4-6 page paper during the final week of classes each semester highlighting what they have learned.

ADD DROP POLICY:

Students should enroll in classes during the first week of the semester. Students may however enroll in this course at any time during the semester with permission of the instructor and registrar. Students enrolling late will have the same journal and paper requirements
