Dual Credit Parent/Guardian Consent Form



In accordance with the 6/3/2015 Coordinating Board for Higher Education Dual Credit Policy, dual credit students must meet the following requirements:

9th Grade

- Overall minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Score at the 90th percentile or above on the ACT or SAT
- Provide signed letter of recommendation from principal and guidance counselor
- Written permission from a parent or legal guardian

10th Grade

- Overall minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale)
- Provide signed letter of recommendation from principal and guidance counselor
- Written permission from a parent or legal guardian

11th and 12th Grades with an overall grade point average between 2.5 - 2.99 (on a 4.0 scale)

- Provide signed letter of recommendation from principal and guidance counselor
- Written permission from a parent or legal guardian

11th and 12th Grades with an overall minimum grade point average of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) are automatically eligible for dual credit courses.
