Measure 2: Indicators of Teaching Effectiveness (MEES Performance Assessment)

DESE has established a statewide Standards-Based Performance Assessment, aligned with the Missouri Teacher Standards, that is used to demonstrate candidate performance in content, coursework, and field experiences during the candidates' internship(s). The Performance Assessment is used as an indicator on DESE's Annual Performance Report (APR) which determines initial certification and accreditation of Education programs in the state. This performance assessment is used to evaluate teacher candidates during student teaching. Both the PreK-12 site-based cooperating teachers and the MWSU EPP-based university supervisors complete the evaluation at multiple time-points. The results included here are summative results from the end of student teaching.

0 = Candidate; 1 = Emerging; 2 = Developing; 3 = Skilled - Target Level; 4 = Exceeding
