

Measure 2: Teaching Effectiveness (First Year Principal Survey)

The Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) gathers data annually on all first-year teachers in the state of Missouri, disaggregated by EPP.

The survey is completed by principals of first-year teachers. The survey contains a question asking principals to rate impact of the teacher on students.
