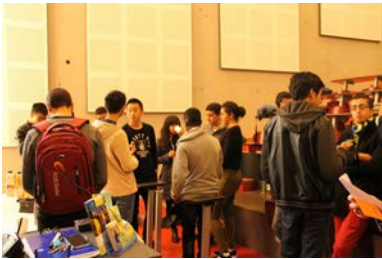

**Jeunes Ambassadeurs:** a program of coaching between a local businessman and an international student

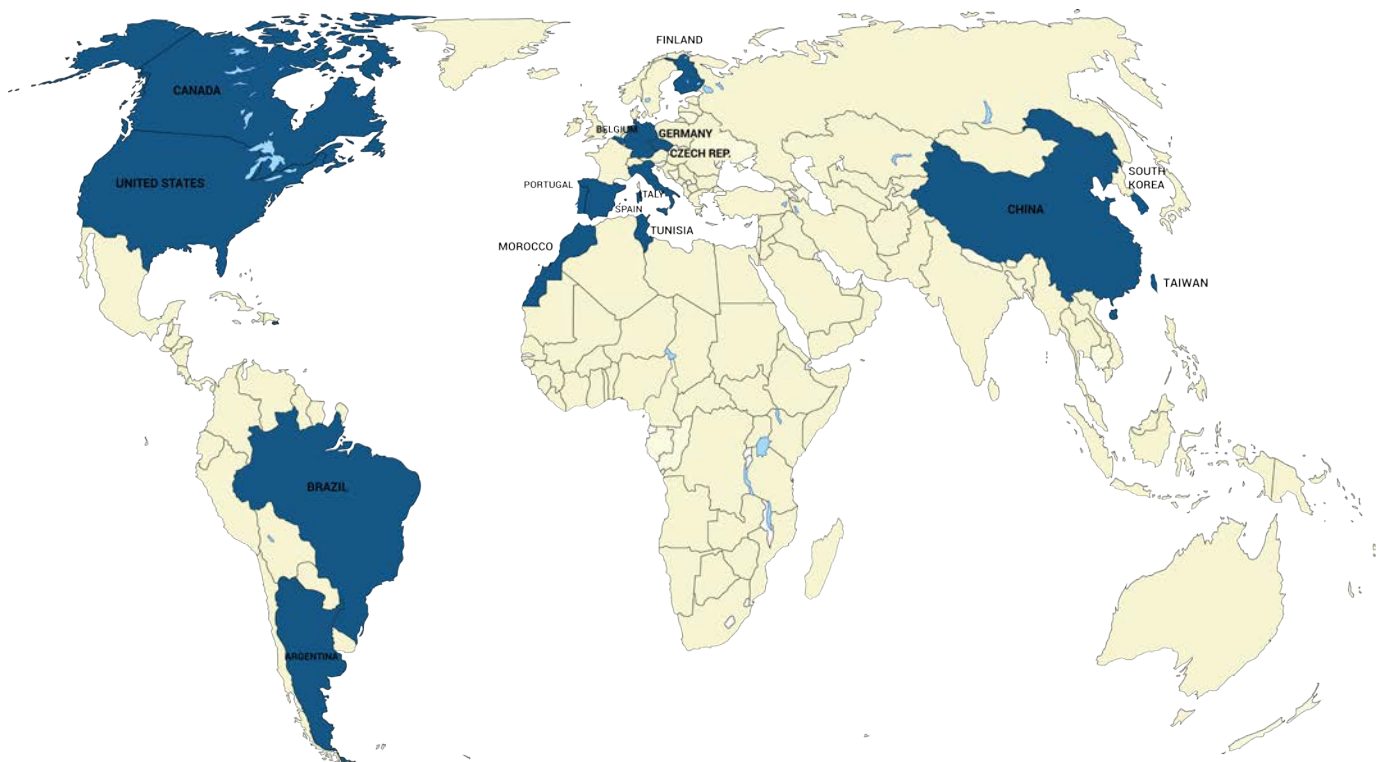
**AGERA:** International students' event in Lyon (guided tour of Lyon and official welcome)

**MELTINGPO'TSE:** a day to discover food and culture from the countries of our international students and from other areas of France (organized by the TSE Students Union)

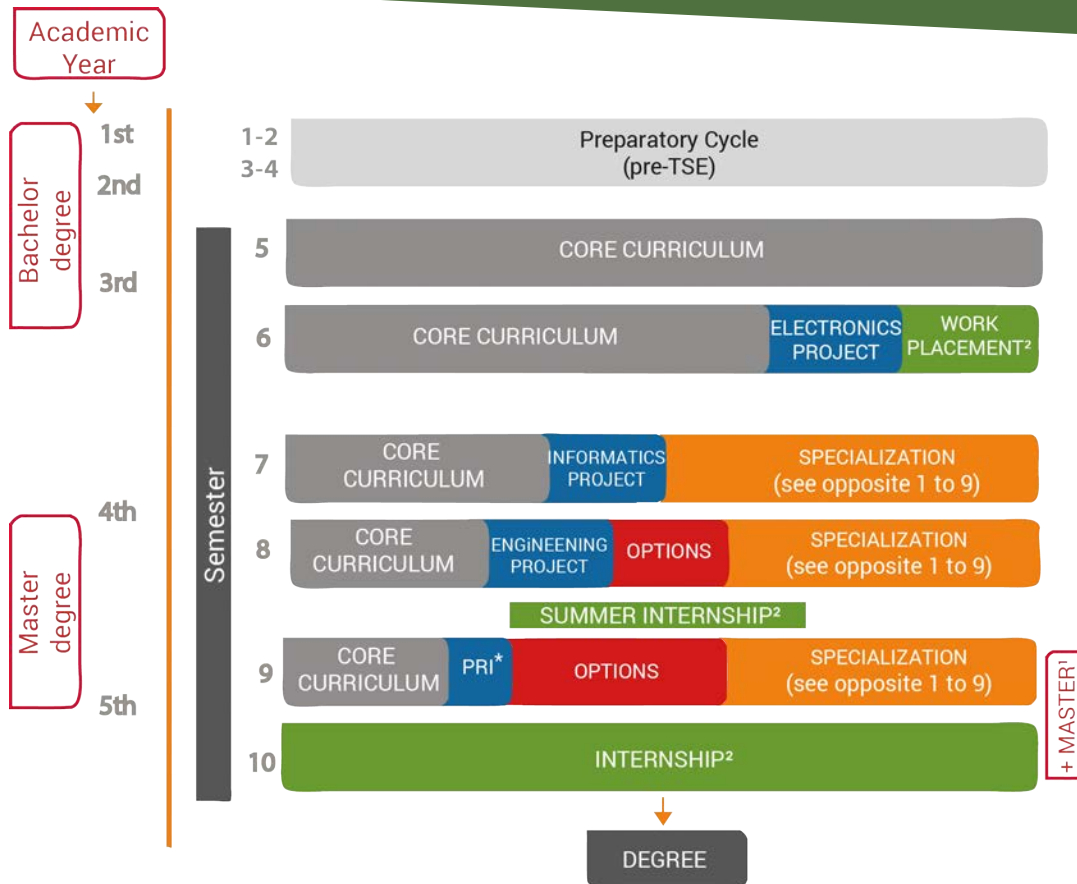
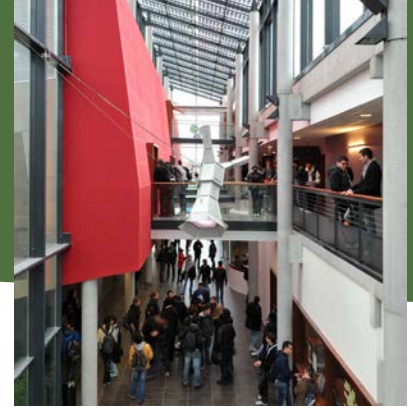
**Gagastronome:** a family from Saint-Etienne invites an international student for a meal in their home

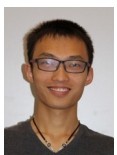

# › HOW TO APPLY

<b>EXCHANGE PROGRAMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students can follow 4<sup>th</sup> year or 5<sup>th</sup> year courses.</li><li>• Students are selected for exchange by their home university.</li><li>• <u>Application deadlines:</u> Winter semester or full year: mid-May Spring semester: late October</li></ul>
<b>NON-EXCHANGE STUDENTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students can apply for entrance to 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year</li><li>• Online applications from November to April: <a href="http://concours.telecom-st-etienne.fr/">http://concours.telecom-st-etienne.fr/</a></li><li>• April: deadline for sending application papers to TSE by post</li><li>• May: interviews in Saint-Etienne</li></ul>
<b>USEFUL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A good level in French is required (most courses at TSE are in French).</li><li>• Possibility to take French courses before the semester begins.</li><li>• Courses at TSE begin 1<sup>st</sup> September (presence compulsory)</li><li>• Cost of living in Saint-Etienne: about 600€ per month (accommodation and other expenses).</li><li>• For more information see our website : <a href="http://www.telecom-st-etienne.fr">http://www.telecom-st-etienne.fr</a></li></ul>
