

Jeunes Ambassadeurs: a program of coaching between a local businessman and an international student


AGERA: International students' event in Lyon (guided tour of Lyon and official welcome)

Welcome week: a day of events to wish our international students a warm welcome (September)


MELTINGPO'TSE: a day to discover food and culture from the countries of our international students and from other areas of France (organized by the TSE Students Union)

>HOW TO APPLY

EXCHANGE PROGRAMS	 Students can follow 4th year or 5th year courses. Students are selected for exchange by their home university. Application deadlines: Winter semester or full year mid-May Spring semester. late October
NON-EXCHANGE STUDENTS	 Students can apply for entrance to 3rd or 4th year Online applications from November to April: http://concours.telecom-st-etienne.fr/ April: deadline for sending application papers to TSE by post May: interviews in Saint-Etienne
USEFUL INFORMATION	 A good level in French is required (most courses at TSE are in French). Possibility to take French courses before the semester begins. Courses at TSE begin 1st September (presence compulsory) Cost of living in Saint-Etienne: about 600€ per month (accomodation and other expenses).
