Deadline: Must provide all required documentation during the admission process prior to the published international admission deadlines:
Fall/August **July 15**, or Spring/January **November 1**.

Please note: Students only need to meet one of the testing options (TOEFL, IELTS or Intensive English), not all three.

Important information:

- The award(s) is automatically applied towards student's cost of tuition when enrolled at Missouri Western State University's St. Joseph campus.
- The Global Griffon Award may not be combined with other Missouri Western awards, such as the Golden Griffon, President's, Governors', Deans' or the IB program. If a student meets multiple scholarship award criteria, he/she may qualify for one highest award category.
- Students must maintain full-time, continuous enrollment at Missouri Western, and pay non-resident tuition. Students will receive an extensive session/seminar on how to maintain or keep the award for their entire degree.
- A student is no longer eligible for the International Excellence Scholarship if he/she receives scholarships from a foreign government-sponsored student program or from Missouri Western athletic scholarship.
- The International Excellence awards are automatic with general application to the University. All awards are contingent upon the availability of funds. When the number of qualified applicants exceeds the number of scholarships to be awarded, recipients will be selected on a competitive basis at the discretion of the University.
