

Canvas Training Course: *Fundamentals of Accessible Digital Content in Canvas*


Digital accessibility provides all students equal access to course content within the Canvas learning environment. Designing instruction, providing accessible materials, and understanding the tools and resources available to you in Canvas will be covered in this 55-minute course. In this course, you'll learn what digital accessibility means and how it applies to the content you create. You'll explore the POUR principles as the foundation for accessible design, understand how to check for accessibility issues in Canvas, and apply best practices for images, files, and course materials. You'll also gain awareness of common accessibility mistakes and discover where to access ongoing support and valuable resources to continuously improve your content's accessibility. The course includes four modules:
