Human Diversity: Analyze the impact of cultural norms, health care practices, and diversity while implementing the professional nursing practice role.

Health Care Policy: Create and influence institutional and public policy through comprehensive understanding and application of the policy making process, including the role of legislative and regulatory policy on professional practice and health care delivery.

Organizational Behavior and

Communication: Assume a leadership role in shaping environments that promote healthy communication. Analyze and manage environments of practice to promote a culture of quality and safety.

Resource Utilization: Assume accountability for the efficient and ethical use of human, environmental, and fiscal resources.
