

The [Department of Education's Federal Regulations 34 CFR 668.43 \(a\)\(5\)\(v\)](#) mandate that each institution inform students of whether their program curriculum, both distance education programs and face-to-face programs, meet the state requirements for each program that leads to licensure or certification.
