ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Completion of all MWSU General Studies requirements
 - Completion of the Missouri Core 42, an Associate of Arts degree (AA) or Bachelor's degree typically meets this requirement
- · Completion of MWSU Nursing Support Courses
 - College Math, Principles of Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy & Physiology, Microbiology, Pathophysiology, Medical Terminology, General Psychology, Lifespan Developmental Psychology, Ethics



PERSONALIZED ATTENTION

- No more than 10 students per 1 clinical instructor
- · Individualized academic advising
- Senior capstone course provides a reality-based experience that prepares student for the transition into the RN role



ACCREDITATION

- The baccalaureate degree program in nursing at Missouri Western State University is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (http://www.ccneaccreditation.org)
- · Fully approved by the Missouri State Board of Nursing

EARLY ACCEPTANCE/NURSING SCHOLAR PROGRAM

- Available to high school juniors/seniors and MWSU freshmen after their first semester
- Granted to students with superior academic achievement
- Automatic entry into the nursing program (if all guidelines met) whenever you are ready

- Nursing program is 4 full-time semesters, or 2 years
- There is no summer requirement

APPLICATION PROCESS

- 120 students accepted annually (60 fall/60 spring)

- Deadlines:
 - -January 15 for fall admission
 - -August 15 for spring admission
