Program Graduation Requirements

- Earn a grade of C or higher in all major coursework.
- Earn an overall GPA of at least 2.0 and a major GPA of at least 2.0.

Program Admission Requirements

- Graduate of a Practical Nursing Program
- Current, unencumbered PN licensure in the US
- Application deadlines:
 - January 15 for fall admission
 - August 15 for spring admission
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 or higher
- Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI TEAS) score of 58.7% or above.
- General studies, prerequisites, and Nursing Support Courses must be completed prior to beginning the nursing program.
 - ALH 106, BIO 101, BIO 250*, BIO 251*, BIO 375*, CHE 101 or 111, PHL 230 or 231, PSY 240*.
 - *Specific nursing support courses (other than general education courses) must have been completed within the previous ten years.
 - Must earn a C or higher in all support courses, as well as General Studies Math.

University Graduation Requirements

- Earn a minimum of 120 credit hours (100 level and higher, maximum of 6 CED credit hours applicable).
- Earn a minimum of 30 credit hours in upper-division courses. Lower-division transfer courses accepted as meeting upper-division departmental course requirements cannot be used to fulfill this requirement.
- Earn 30 of the last 45 credit hours at MWSU in institutional coursework (exclusive of credit by examination).
- Participate in required departmental and campus wide assessments.
- Fulfill the Missouri Constitution requirement.
- Successfully pass the Missouri Higher Education Civics Achievement exam.
