Approval of Research on Human Subjects Employment Policies

Missouri Western State University has established a committee on the use of human subjects in research (CUHSR) in accordance with the guidelines established by the Public Health Service. The committee members are approved by the Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs. The committee is comprised of the Interim Graduate Dean/Faculty member (Chairperson), at least one scientist, at least one non-scientist, and at least one individual not otherwise associated with the University; the committee is composed of at least five members.

The Missouri Western State University CUHSR has established policies and procedures for research on human subjects. Any Missouri Western State University employee conducting research on human subjects is expected to conform to these policies (see Appendix S). Note that some types of research require review by the Missouri Western State University CUHSR prior to beginning the research. Institutional review of research on human subjects is required by all federal funding agencies, most other extramural funding agencies, and many professional journals. Application materials may be obtained from the Interim Graduate Dean/Faculty member.
