President Wilson Report:

- Update on new initiatives. Changing so quickly because we need to out of financial necessity and need to attract students.
- Incoming class down by about 10%.
- Redoing budget to be realistic to our situation.
- We will see shifts in personnel. ie. Admissions, bringing in students will pay for the additional personnel.
- Going in to high schools and speaking; Presidential speakers team to guest lecture in classes.
- J.P. Yates to lead Admissions with Paul Orscheln leaving.
- Griffon Guarantee scholarship rolled out. Starts at a low threshold. In the beginning, spends less than what we are currently. Helps with retention. Graduation rate is 35% and this will help.
- Center for Service is great opportunity to raise some money and bring some students in.
- Gold Fridays opens up a day for work, service, study groups, appointments, lab days, etc. Good recruitment tool.
- Global Center. Shifting of resources.
- Esports. Using it to drive enrollment. Something that drives enrollment and helps with recruitment. Has an academic component; has a concentration and a minor in the works. Partially funded by Student Government.
- 4 day work weeks is detrimental to recruiting by being shut down on Fridays. Flex time where coverage for five days is available will be an option. 4 day work weeks is not a cost savings to the University.

Dr. Davenport Report:

- Gold Friday scheduling has been tested and works with the rooms we have available.
- Esports falls under the Strategic plan; "student experience".
- Vice provost search is coming to a conclusion; thanks to all that have participated.
- Academic Administrative restructuring feedback sessions coming up. There are 3 models.
