### Why You Need an FAA Part 107 Certificate — [No Exceptions](#)

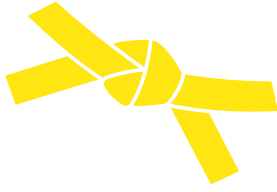


If you fly a drone for any business purpose — even just once, even if you're not getting paid directly — the FAA requires you to hold a Part 107 Remote Pilot Certificate. This isn't a formality. It's federal law.

- Using drone photos to sell a house? That's commercial use.
- Mapping a field, checking on cattle, or scouting crops for your farm business? That's commercial use.
- Inspecting a roof for a damage estimate or insurance claim? That's commercial use.
- Posting drone footage to monetize social media or using it to promote a business? That's commercial use.

Flying commercially without a Part 107 certificate isn't a gray area. It's a violation that can carry fines of \$1,000+ per incident, civil penalties up to \$27,500, and in serious cases, criminal charges.
